

2020 ISFAA-ICHE Webinar Series – Program Overview – Next Level Jobs, Adult Student Grant, Workforce Ready Grant – Questions and Answers

It's okay to complete the WRG CT, then continue to the longer technical certificate program - correct?

Previously, our guidance has been that students who have earned a college degree of any kind (including associate degrees) OR a Workforce Ready Grant-eligible certificate are not eligible to receive funding from the Workforce Ready Grant, with no exceptions. However, there are two exceptions we need to understand:

- (1) Some of the WRG-eligible certificates are stackable with other WRG-eligible certificates. We'll pay for both certificates, since the coursework for the longer WRG-eligible certificate includes all of the coursework for the shorter WRG-eligible certificate.
- (2) Students who earn a WRG-eligible certificate before high school graduation are not disqualified from earning another WRG-eligible certificate.

Is there a deadline to apply for the Adult student grant?

No deadline... Adult Student Grant is first-come, first-served.

Will enrollment requirements for the summer 2020 term be different than the regular enrollment requirements?

No. We do have summer exceptions that are in place, and we will be sending out a reminder shortly of what those exceptions are.
