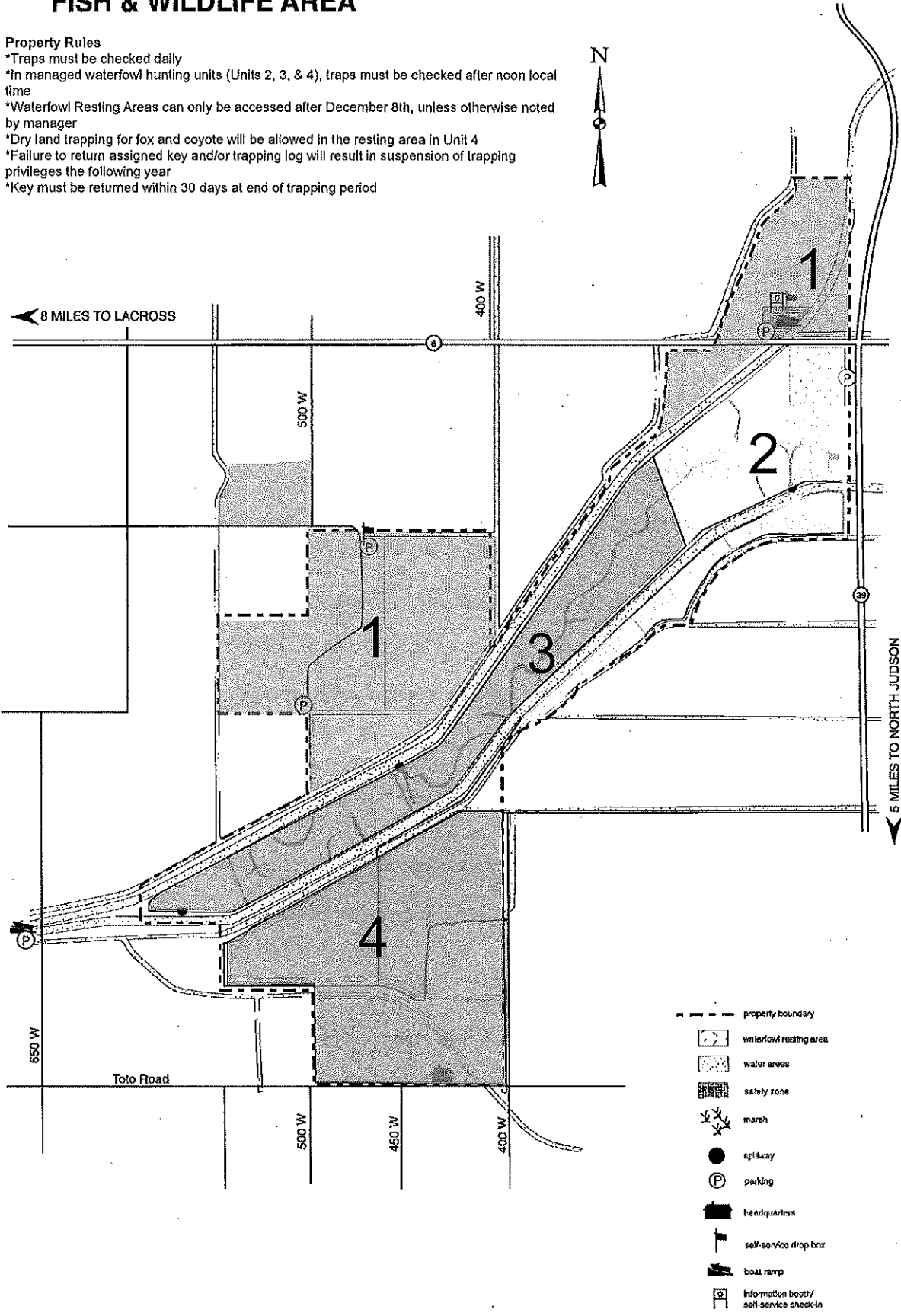


KANKAKEE FISH & WILDLIFE AREA

Property Rules

- *Traps must be checked daily
- *In managed waterfowl hunting units (Units 2, 3, & 4), traps must be checked after noon local time
- *Waterfowl Resting Areas can only be accessed after December 8th, unless otherwise noted by manager
- *Dry land trapping for fox and coyote will be allowed in the resting area in Unit 4
- *Failure to return assigned key and/or trapping log will result in suspension of trapping privileges the following year
- *Key must be returned within 30 days at end of trapping period

Trapping Rules

- *This permit allows the person(s) named on this document to set traps for furbearers on the above named
- Indiana Division of Fish & Wildlife property within the listed trapping unit and time period.

- *All traps and snares must be set underwater and remain completely covered by water except for cage type
- traps or dog proof foot traps with a pull type trigger and an opening of 2 inches in diameter or less.

- *This permit is not transferable and conveys no rights or privileges except that of trapping for furbearers in
- a specified trapping unit.

- *It is the permittee's responsibility to determine the location of property and trapping unit boundaries
- and to trap only within those boundaries.

- *The permittee shall attach no liability to the Indiana Department of Natural Resources, its members, officers,
- or other employees for any personal injury, loss of personal property, or damage occasioned by other property users' activities during the term of this permit.

- *The state reserves the right to control nuisance beavers in all trapping units. The state will exercise this right if the permittee does not or is unable to trap beavers as requested by the property manager.

- *The trapper must report accidental catches of protected furbearers (river otter, badger, bobcat) or domestic
- animals (dog, cats) to the property manager within 24 hours of capture. These non-target animals are to be
- released by the trapper immediately, or if the animal is dead, the carcass is to be given to property personnel.

- *Violation of state laws, property regulations, and/or the conditions of this permit will cause the permittee
- to be denied consideration for trapping privileges in the future and for this permit to be immediately revoked.

- *A complete record of furbearers trapped on these lands must be kept by species, and must be submitted
- to the property manager no later than 14 days following the end of the trapping period.

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
